### **What you'll do:**

- Ensure safety and prevent injuries by supervising pool area. Scan pool and pool area every 10 seconds and react immediately to signs of individuals in distress. Maintain all aquatics/pools standards and rules. Ensure no distraction or interference with the ability to hear or see signs of distress.
- Ensure that pool staffing is within YMCA standards before leaving the area or performing maintenance items. Ensure security upon arrival and departure.
- Administer first aid to victims using OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Universal Precautions. Provide immediate care to sustain life until Emergency Medical Service arrives.

### **What you need to succeed:**

- Minimum 16 years of age with current YMCA or ARC Lifeguard, CPR/AED for Professional Rescuer and ARC First Aid certifications.
- Ability to use water test kit.
- Exhibit strong leadership skills
