- Ensure safety and prevent injuries by supervising pool area. Scan pool and pool area every 10 seconds and react immediately to signs of individuals in distress.
- Maintain all aquatics/pools standards and rules.
- Ensure no distraction or interference with the ability to hear or see signs of distress.
- Ensure that pool staffing is within YMCA standards before leaving the area or performing maintenance items.
- Ensure security upon arrival and departure.
- Administer first aid to victims using OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Universal Precautions.
- Provide immediate care to sustain life until Emergency Medical Service arrives.
- Perform endurance swims, rescue procedures upon request.
- Participate as a part of the aquatics staff team in providing a safe and enjoyable environment.
- Respect others by arriving on time and in accordance with schedule.

What you need to succeed:

- Minimum 16 years of age with current YMCA or ARC Lifeguard, CPR/AED for Professional Rescuer and ARC First Aid certifications.
- Ability to use water test kit.
- Exhibit strong leadership skills; possess a passion for member service, building and maintaining a culture of customer service excellence
