- Submit monthly lesson plans, weekly and specialized reports, and supply requests to the Program Director in a timely manner.

What you need to succeed:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in early childhood education, child development, special education, elementary education, or the human services field or acquire SACC credential or master's degree equivalent if undergraduate degree in unrelated field.
- At least 2 years experience working with children.
- A minimum of 6 hours of child development training per year as defined by DPW.
- Complete Keystone STARS training hours in accordance with your branch's STAR level.
