- Ensure quality program delivery by certified staff and effective use of resources including staffing.
- Perform aquatic office management tasks.
- Ensure the swimming facility is meeting or exceeding the Aquatic Safety Standards.
- Facilitate monthly in-service meetings that include skill review.
- Supervise staff and ensure appropriate staffing of pool. Coordinate breaks and rotate staff. .
- Ensure safety and prevent injuries by supervising pool area. Ensure no distraction or interference with the ability to hear or see signs of distress.
- Ensure safety and cleanliness by picking up all paper, hair, pins, towels and items in pool area.
- Maintain accurate records, certification binder, pool logs.
- Perform pool maintenance duties in accordance with OSHA Hazardous Materials Precautions.

What you need to succeed:

- Bachelor's degree in related field or equivalent experience with 1-3 aquatic and supervisory experience.
- 21 years of age with current YMCA or ARC Lifeguard, CPR for Professional Rescuer and First Aid and YMCA Swim Lesson Instructor or WSI certifications with 2 years of related experience.
- Ability to work a non-traditional schedule including nights and weekends.
- Ability to use chemistry test kit.
